I am requesting funding for the Powhite Parkway Extension Phase II – Preliminary Engineering project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Chesterfield County, located at 9901 Lori Road, Chesterfield, Virginia 23832.

The funding would support geotechnical services, services, and preliminary bridge design efforts associated with the second phase of the Powhite Parkway Extension project. Phase II will complete the parkway from Woolridge Road to U.S. Route 360, including access to the Upper Magnolia Green site.
